


Updates from the Tampa Bay Health & Medical Preparedness Coalition—June 2023

June is Alzheimer's & Brain Awareness Month

Alzheimer's and dementia don't come with an instruction manual, but there are resources available to help. Use these free education programs to learn more about what to expect and how to prepare for the future. Programs for caregivers:

- <u>Dementia Conversations: Driving, Doctor Visits, Legal & Financial Planning</u> Learn to have honest and caring conversations about common concerns when someone begins to show signs of dementia.
- <u>Effective Communication Strategies</u> Learn to decode the verbal and behavioral messages delivered by someone with dementia, and identify strategies to help you connect and communicate at each stage of the disease.
- <u>Understanding and Responding to Dementia-Related Behavior</u> Learn about some of the common triggers for behaviors associated with dementia, how to assess the person's needs, and how to intervene effectively in this educational training program for non-professional caregivers.
